

Greenland Open Space Competitive Trail Ride

Larkspur (North of Colorado Springs), CO Rider Limit: 25 Type: Leisure
June 27, 2021

Join us for a day of competitive trail riding at Douglas County's Greenland Open Space located less than a mile off I-25 between Colorado Springs and Castle Rock, Colorado. Enjoy views of the mountains while you ride on well-maintained trails. The terrain is gentle rolling hills with some scrub oak

Trail: The trails offer fantastic footing on dirt / sandy single track trails with small to moderate elevation changes. You will ride 8.5 miles at an average speed of 3.5 mph (mostly walking with occasional trotting).

Directions to Camp: From I-25, exit the Greenland exit 167. Turn west for $\frac{1}{4}$ mile, then south $\frac{1}{2}$ mile into park. Camp will be in a field east of the normal parking lot and north of the dog parking lot.

General Information: Horse water will be available in the parking lot (bring a bucket). Bring your own people water. Dogs must be on leash at all times. There is cell phone reception in the parking lot and on the trail.

Schedule: Leisure Ride check in (receive rider packet) starts at 9:30 a.m. Horse and rider check in with judge starts 10:15-10:30 a.m. and again after trail briefing (go over maps/trails etc.) which starts at 10:40 a.m. Timing out begins shortly after last horse checks in with judge.

A competitive trail ride **clinic** is offered in the morning of the ride and contains about 2 hours of lectures and demonstrations. Clinic description is available at <https://rms.natrc.net> or contact the ride secretary. Space is limited and there is time to do both the clinic and the ride.

Rules: Ride will be conducted under current NATRC rules. Out-of-state horses are required to have a current Coggins and Health Certificate. Be prepared to show the ride secretary.

Awards: Awards will be 1st through 6th for 3 classes (Adult, Experienced, and Junior).

Meals: On your own.

Judges: TBD

Entry Fees: Adult: \$60 for NATRC members and \$85 for non-members*; Junior: \$40 for NATRC members (includes Region 3 \$10 discount) and \$75 for non-members*. Fees include national fees, regional fees, and drug fees. Payment in full is due within 5 days of registration on RMS (<https://rms.natrc.net>) but before the ride. Registration closes June 22nd. Make checks payable to **Tanglewood Ranch** and mail to the Ride Secretary. Refunds through June 20th less \$15 administration fee. No show, no refund. Venmo accepted at @Diane-Wingle
