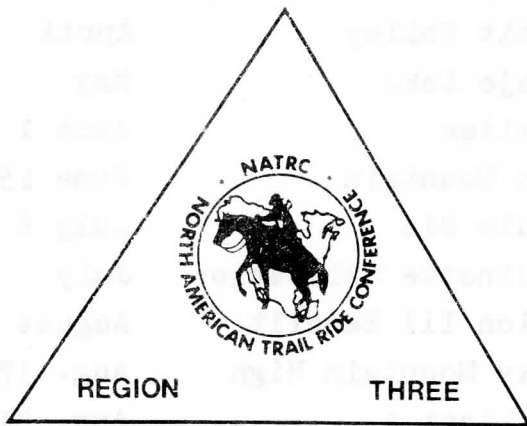

--Region III donated \$200.00 to NATRC National for Year End Convention Awards.--

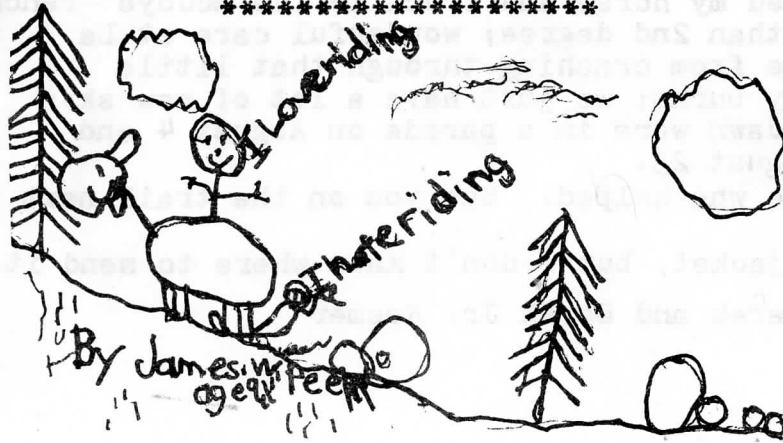

We have all recovered, no burns worse than 2nd degree; wonderful care at La Plata Community Hospital. Alma's bruises from crashing through that little window lasted longer than my son's and my burns; we just have a lot of new skin with all the calluses gone. Me and Mustdawn were in a parade on August 4 and finished 11th in an endurance ride on August 25.

Again, our deepest thanks to all those who helped. See you on the trail next year.

REGION III-NORTH AMERICAN TRAIL RIDE CONFERENCE-1985

Dear Trail Rider,

Our records show that you have ridden in one or more NATRC competitive trail rides in Region III (the Rocky Mountain Region) as a non-member or as a member of National and/or Region III. We hope that this was an enjoyable experience and that you will be entering more of the competitive trail rides in this and future years.

NATIONAL NATRC MEMBERSHIP In order to be more aware of what is happening in trail riding and to SAVE \$3.00 on each ride's entry fee, we would like to suggest that you join the National organization of NATRC if you are not currently a member. A membership blank for National NATRC can be found below. Membership in NATRC will allow you to receive all issues of the National newsletter, HOOFPRINTS each year instead of just one that the National organization sends to every rider who rode in a NATRC ride this year. You will also be eligible for numerous year-end AWARDS given at the National convention in November. Members can also VOTE for representation on the National Board of Directors. Please return the enclosed application to the California address with the proper fee.

REGION III MEMBERSHIP In addition members of the National NATRC are eligible to join the local Region III organization if you desire. A membership blank and dues statement are enclosed. Members in the Region III organization qualify for the year-end Region III AWARDS which include: Novice Horse, Novice Horsemanship, Open Horsemanship, Accumulative Horse mileage and Accumulative Rider mileage in both Novice and Open Divisions. None of these awards are given on a National basis. Also it entitles you to VOTE on matters that pertain to rides, riders and judges in the mountain states. There is also a regular NEWSLETTER mailed in addition to the National newsletter to all members of Region III to keep you informed of happenings in our local trail rides. Your name will also appear on a LIST that ride managers can request on below so that they will know who might be interested in attending their ride.

So that our listings will be complete as early as possible before the coming ride year, we are making our membership payment due by January 31 of 1984. Riders new during the ride season may join until the last trail ride of the season. We will appreciate your returning the membership blank and your check as soon as possible.

RIDE MANAGERS If you would like address labels for ride entries that you send out you may get them from the address below. The labels will include all Reg. III members, all NATRC members living in Region III and all riders who have ridden a Region III ride in the last year. Please contact us a couple of weeks before you need the labels. Send it with your membership form now and we can double check your mileage. (Since we do not want to be doing this all year this is a limited offer which expires Jan. 31. The sooner you get them to us the better for us.)
